

Town and Country Planning Act, 1947

The Minister of Transport and Civil Aviation hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 49 of the above Act, entitled "The Stopping up of Highways (City and County Borough of Birmingham) (No. 4) Order, 1959" authorising the stopping up of part of Masefield Square, Kings Norton, Birmingham, and requiring the provision of two new roads.
