WYE RIVER BOARD

Fishery Byelaws

Notice is hereby given that the Wye River Board intend to apply at the expiration of one calendar month from the date of the publication of this notice for the confirmation by the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food of the following Byelaws:

8A. *Use of Maggots as Bait*

No person shall use as bait between the 14th day of March and the 26th day of October next following in any year any maggot, grub or larvae, whether natural or artificial when fishing with rod and line in any of the undermentioned waters:

River Wye
River Ithon and its tributaries
River Irfon and its tributaries
River Marteg
River Llynfi, downstream of Llangorse Eel Trap
River Duhonw
River Edw
River Elan, below Caban Coch Dam
River Lugg and its tributaries.

12. *Prohibited Instruments*

No person shall, without the previous consent in writing of the River Board, take or attempt to take within the River Board Area any Salmon, Trout, Freshwater Fish or Eels by means of any
