*Town and Country Planning Act, 1947*

The Minister of Transport and Civil Aviation hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 49 of the above Act, authorising the stopping up of a length of the Shawbury—Shrewsbury Road (A.53) in order to enable the development of Shawbury R.A.F. Station to be carried out by the Air Ministry.

The proposed Order will also require the provision of a substitute road repairable by the inhabitants at large, for which the highway authority is to be the Salop C.C.

*Trunk Roads Act, 1946*

*Special Roads Act, 1949*

*Laceby By-Pass Extension*

The Minister of Transport and Civil Aviation hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 1 of the Trunk Roads Act, 1946, as extended by section 14 of the Special Roads Act, 1949, providing that an extension of the Laceby By-Pass which he proposes to construct at Laceby in the County of Lincoln, Parts of Lindsey will become a trunk road on the date when the Order comes into operation and the length of the Sheffield—Grimsby Trunk Road to be superseded thereby will cease to be a trunk road on 1st April next after the date on which notice is given by the Minister to the County Council of Lincoln, Parts of Lindsey (who will thereafter become the highway authority responsible for that length) that the said extension is opened for through traffic.

Copies of the Order, the title of which is "The Sheffield—Grimsby Trunk Road (Laceby By-Pass Extension) Order, 1959", can be purchased, price 3d., either through any bookseller or direct from Her Majesty's Stationery Office at 39-41 King Street, Manchester 2.

Copies of the Order and of the relevant plan have been deposited at the offices of the Ministry of Transport and Civil Aviation, 21-37 Hereford Road, London W.2, and the Lincoln, Parts of Lindsey C.C., County Offices, Lincoln, and may be seen at all reasonable hours.

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Trunk Roads Act, 1946, as amended by the Special Roads Act, 1949, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Trunk Roads Act, 1946, as so amended has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within six weeks of 14th July 1959, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.
