The Minister of Transport and Civil Aviation hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 49 of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1947, and section 32 of the Mineral Workings Act, 1951, authorising the temporary stopping up for a period of fifteen years of a length of footpath at Reach Lane, Heath and Reach, Beds., in order to enable development, consisting of excavation for the winning of sand, to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted to Bedford Silica Sand Mines Ltd. by Luton R.D.C.
