The Importation of Carcases and Animal Products (Amendment) Order, 1959

(Made 13th August 1959)

This Order, which comes into operation on 13th December 1959, alters the requirements of the Importation of Carcases and Animal Products Order, 1954, relating to meat, including edible offals, im-ported into Great Britain from Argentina, Brazil, Chile and Uruguay. The new requirement is that each consignment must be accompanied by a certifi-cate that it has been exported from recognised frigorificos.
