Notice is hereby further given that any person who desires to question the validity of the said revised map on the ground that the map is not within the powers of the above Act, or on the ground that any requirement of the above Act or of any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the preparation of the map or of the revised maps in draft and provisional form on which the map is based, may, within six weeks after the date of publication of this notice, make an application to the High Court in accordance with the provisions of Paragraph 9 of Part III of the First Schedule to the above Act.

Notice is hereby given that on the 22nd day of September 1959, the Minister of Housing and Local Government confirmed (with modifications) the above Order.
