Town and Country Planning Act, 1947

The Minister of Transport and Civil Aviation hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 49 of the above Act, authorising the stopping up of a length of Hadow Road, Bournemouth, in order to enable development, consisting of an extension to playing fields, to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted under Part III of the Act.

The proposed Order will also require the provision of a new footpath repairable by the inhabitants at large, for which the highway authority is to be the Bournemouth C.B.C.
