### NATIONAL PARKS AND ACCESS TO THE COUNTRYSIDE ACT, 1949

*Rural District of Warminster and Westbury  
 (Parish of Heywood, Footpath No. 11)  
 Extinguishment Order, 1959*

Notice<sup>a</sup> is hereby given that the Minister of Housing and Local Government in pursuance of the powers conferred upon him by section 44 of the above Act, after consultation with the Warminster and Westbury Rural District Council proposes to make an Order for the extinguishment of part of footpath No. 11 Heywood, in the Rural District of Warminster and Westbury in the County of Wiltshire.

The draft Order relates to land situate in the parish of Heywood.

The effect of the Order will be to extinguish the public right of way leading from its junction with footpath No. 10, which leads from Hawkeridge to Brook House Farm, at a point south-east of Court Farm and approximately one hundred yards south-west of the junction of footpath No. 10 with the main Hawkeridge—Westbury road, in a south-westerly direction across field O.S. No. 114 for a distance of approximately five hundred yards to the boundary of the War Department Depot in the south-western corner of the said field.

A copy of the draft Order and of the map contained therein has been deposited at the Council Offices, Craven House, Warminster, Wiltshire, and at the Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, and will be open for inspection free of charge during normal office hours.

Any objection or representation with reference to the draft Order may be sent in writing to the Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, before 9th November 1959, and any such objection or representation should state the grounds on which it is made.
