

DERWENT VALLEY WATER BOARD

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Housing and Local Government has, by an Order dated the 20th October 1959, and made under section 1 of the Water Act, 1958, empowered the Derwent Valley Water Board, until the 19th January 1960—

(a) to reduce the compensation water discharged by them out of the Ladybowser Reservoir into the River Derwent in the Rural District of Chapel-en-le-Frith to seven million, four hundred and eighty-two thousand five hundred gallons per day, and

(b) to reduce the compensation water discharged by them into Jagers Clough Stream in the said Rural District of Chapel-en-le-Frith to one million eight hundred and seventy-five thousand gallons per day.

METROPOLITAN BOROUGH OF FULHAM

The Fulham Borough Council (No. 3) Smoke Control Order, 1959

1. Notice is hereby given that the Council of the Metropolitan Borough of Fulham in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act, 1956, on the 5th day of October 1959, made an Order entitled the Fulham Borough Council (No. 3) Smoke Control Order, 1959, declaring the area described in the schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

2. Subject to the exemptions provided by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £10 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

3. Copies of the Order and of the Map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Town Clerk's Office, Town Hall, Fulham, London S.W.6, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 30th day of October 1959.

4. Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to The Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.
