On the 16th day of October 1959, the Ipswich County Borough Council made the above mentioned Orders under the Road Traffic Act, 1930, as amended, to come into operation on the 1st day of December 1959, the effect of which is:

- 1. To amend the County Borough of Ipswich (Traffic Regulation) (Amendment) Order, 1956, by substituting in Item 5 of the First Schedule the words "the south-east side of Princes Street between a point the south-east side of Princes Street between a point sixty-three yards south-west of its junction with Queen Street and a point thirty-three yards north-east of its junction with Friars Street" for the words "the south-east side of Princes Street between its junction with Friars Street and its junction with Queen Street."
- 2. To amend the County Borough Council of Ipswich (Traffic Regulation) (No. 3) Order, 1950, by deleting from the Schedule to the said Order Item 11 (the east side of Museum Street between its junction with Princes Street and its junction with Elm Street) and Item 12 (the west side of Museum Street between its junction with Princes Street and its junction with

Elm Street).

3. That no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8 a.m. and 8 p.m. on any week day in any of the lengths or parts of the roads specified in the first Schedule hereto.

4. That no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8 a.m. and 8 p.m. in any of the lengths of road specified in the second Schedule hereto,

(a) For a longer period than one hour or(b) If a period of less than one hour has elapsed since the termination of the last period of waiting (if any) of the vehicle in that part of the road.

- 5. That no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8 a.m. and 8 p.m. on Museum Street between its junction with Elm Street and its junction with Princes Street
- . (a) On the east side of any Monday, Thursday or

(b) On the west side on any Tuesday, Thursday or
Saturday or

(c) On the side of that length of road on which vehicles are not for the time being prohibited from waiting under paragraph (a) or (b)—

: (i) for a longer period than one hour or (ii) if a period of less than one hour has elapsed since the termination during the said hours of the last period of waiting (if any) of the vehicle on that side.

6. That no person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on the eastern side of the island in Derby Road between its junction with Foxhall Road and its junction with Pearce Road otherwise than in

Exceptions are made in the Orders to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for boarding or alighting from a vehicle, to enable goods to be loaded or unloaded, and to enable a vehicle to be used in connection with a funeral or with building operations and maintenance, of the road and the services therein.
