

DEVON COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Devon (Common Lane, Beer) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1959

The Devon County Council propose to make an Order under the Road Traffic Act, 1930, as amended, the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting by vehicles on Common Lane, Beer, between its junctions with Fore Street and Southdown Road, from 1st June to 30th September in every year.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle; to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle; to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or the services therein; to enable the vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage situated on or adjacent to the length of road; to enable the vehicle to be used as part of a funeral cortege or otherwise in connection with a funeral.

CITY OF SALFORD

The City of Salford (Traffic Regulation) Order No. 11, 1959

The Salford City Council propose to make an Order made under the Road Traffic Act, 1930, as amended the effect of which will be (a) that no person may drive any vehicles in Grantham Street, Salford 5, except from Taylorson Street in the direction of Ordsall Lane and (b) that no person may cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.0 a.m. and 6.0 p.m. except for certain specified purposes on the north easterly side of Grantham Street between Taylorson Street and Ordsall Lane.

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT, 1947

FISHGUARD AND GOODWICK URBAN DISTRICT COUNCIL

Notice is hereby given that the Fishguard and Goodwick Urban District Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 42 of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1947, on the 23rd day of October 1959, made an appropriation Order entitled The Fishguard and Goodwick Urban District Council Appropriation Order, 1959, which is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation, authorising the appropriation for the purpose of securing its use in the manner specified in the County of Pembroke Development Plan, that is, as a football and recreation ground, of land forming part of Goodwick Moor, which is now held for open space purposes.
