Compensation Water

The Minister of Housing and Local Government has made an Order entitled "The Claro Water Board (Drought) Order, 1959" (S.I. 1959 No. 1762) authorising a reduction in the compensation water discharged from the Roundhill Reservoir from one million gallons per day to five hundred thousand gallons per day and a copy of this Order may be inspected at the Claro Water Board's Offices, being the Municipal Offices, Crescent Gardens, Harrogate.

CLARO WATER BOARD

Compensation Water

Notice is hereby given that the Claro Water Board have applied to the Minister of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London, for an Order under section 1 of the Water Act, 1958, to be in force until 31st March 1960, to the effect:

- (1) that the obligation of the Board to discharge compensation water from the Roundhill Reservoir as required by section 15 of the Harrogate Water Act 1901 (applied to the Board by paragraph 33 of the Claro Water Board Order, 1958) shall cease entirely when the level of the water in the reservoir is 47 feet below the sill of the overflow of the reservoir;
- (2) that the terms of the Claro Water Board (Drought) Order, 1959, permitting the Board to reduce the quantity of compensation water required to be discharged from the Roundhill Reservoir by five hundred thousand gallons every twenty-four hours shall be extended until the 31st day of March 1960.

Any objection to the proposed Order must be made in writing to "The Minister of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall S.W.1," within seven

days of the date of publication of this notice. It is requested that a copy of any such objection may at the same time be sent to the undersigned.

PRESTON AND DISTRICT WATER BOARD

Whereas by reason of exceptional shortage of rain a serious deficiency of supplies of water is threatened in the limits of supply of the Preston and District Water Board (hereinafter called "the Board") and whereas by section 25 of the Preston Corporation Act, 1921 as amended by section 18 of the Preston Corporation Act, 1947 (both of which enactments were applied to the Board by the Preston and District Water Board Order, 1959) the Board are empowered to take water from the Langden and Hareden Streams subject to the following restrictions:

(a) if and so long as there is passing down the Langden and Hareden Streams immediately above the points of intake by the Board quantities of water which together do not exceed eight million gallons per day of twenty-four hours the Board may for the purposes of their water undertaking take appropriate and use water at the rate per day of the excess beyond three million gallons:

(b) if and so long as there is passing down the Langden and Hareden Streams immediately above the points of intake by the Board quantities of water which together exceed eight million gallons per day of twenty-four hours the Board may for the purposes of their water undertaking take appropriate and use water at the rate per day of five million gallons and in addition three-fourths of the excess beyond the said eight million gallons:

Provided that the maximum quantity of water so to be taken by the Board in any one day shall not exceed twenty-four million gallons.
