In accordance with section 77 of the National Insurance Act, 1946, the National Insurance Advisory Committee give notice that they have received from the Minister of Pensions and National Insurance for consideration and report thereon the preliminary draft of regulations entitled the National Insurance (Earnings) (No. 2) Regulations, 1959.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

These Regulations provide that the amount of earnings which is disregarded for the purposes of reducing the weekly rate of retirement or widow's pension or a widowed mother's allowance on account of the beneficiary's earnings shall be increased in the case of a retirement or widow's pension from 60 shillings to 70 shillings and in the case of a widowed mother's allowance from 80 shillings to 100 shillings. The reduction of benefit for earnings in excess of this amount continues to be 6d. for each shilling of the first 20 shillings of the excess and 1 shilling for each shilling thereafter.

The Regulations revoke, with appropriate savings, the National Insurance (Earnings) Regulations, 1959, by which these amounts were last increased.
