

"3. The territory to be annexed to the parish of Saint Helens :

"(a) All those parts (coloured purple on the map lettered B annexed hereto) of the parish of Saint Luke, Eccleston, which lie (1) to the northeast of the middle of Lingholme Road and (2) to the north of the middle of Windle Brook.

"(b) All those parts (coloured yellow on the map lettered B annexed hereto) of the parish of Saint Thomas, Eccleston, which lie generally to the north and east of the imaginary line described in clause 12 (b) of this Scheme.

"4. The territory to be annexed to the parish of Holy Trinity, Parr Mount :

"(a) All that part (coloured brown on the map lettered C annexed hereto) of the parish of Saint Peter, Parr, which lies generally to the southwest of an imaginary line commencing at a point on the boundary which divides the parish of Holy Trinity, Parr Mount, from the parish of Saint Peter, Parr, in the middle of Islands Brow Bridge and extending thence generally eastwards along the middle of the Saint Helens Canal for a distance of 30 yards thence generally southwards at a distance of approximately 30 yards to the east of the middle of Merton Bank Road to the Northern end of the wall or fence forming the eastern boundary of the house and premises known as Number 10 Roper Street thence generally southeastwards along the last mentioned wall or fence and along the walls or fences at the rear of the houses and premises situated on the eastern side of Merton Bank Road to the northwestern end of the wall or fence forming the northwestern boundary of the house and premises known as Number 79 Park Road thence southeastwards along the last mentioned wall or fence to its end thence southeastwards across Park Road to the northwestern end of the wall or fence forming the northeastern boundary of the house and premises known as Number 76 Park Road thence south eastwards along the last mentioned wall or fence and along the walls or fences at the rear of the houses and premises on the southwestern side of Ross Street to the northwestern end of the wall or fence forming the northeastern boundary of the house and premises known as Number 21 Recreation Street thence southeastwards along the last mentioned wall or fence and in the same straight line to a point in the middle of Recreation Street thence northeastwards along the middle of the last mentioned Street to a point opposite the middle of the southeastern end of Ross Street thence southeastwards in a straight line through Parr Recreation Ground to the middle of Sankey Brook thence generally southwestwards along the middle of the last mentioned Brook to the boundary which divides the parish of Saint Peter, Parr, from the parish of Holy Trinity, Parr Mount.

"(b) All that part (coloured purple on the map lettered C annexed hereto) of the parish of Sutton which lies to the northwest and north of an imaginary line commencing at a point on the boundary which divides the parish of Holy Trinity, Parr Mount, from the parish of Sutton in the middle of Sutton Road opposite the southwestern end of Gaskell Street and extending thence eastwards along the middle of Sutton Road for a distance of approximately 75 yards to the point where an unnamed stream or brook passes under the road thence first southwestwards to and then southwestwards and westwards along the middle of the unnamed stream or brook (which forms the boundary between closes numbered 808 and 765) to the boundary which divides the parish of Sutton from the parish of Saint John the Evangelist, Ravenhead.

"(c) All that part (coloured pink on the map lettered C annexed hereto) of the parish of Saint John the Evangelist, Ravenhead, excluding that part to be annexed to the parish of Sutton under clause 5 (a) of this Scheme, which lies generally to the east of an imaginary line commencing at a point on the boundary which divides the parish of Saint John the Evangelist, Ravenhead, from the parish of Sutton in the middle of Sherdley Road where the said boundary turns generally eastwards and extending thence northeastwards along the middle of the last mentioned Road to the point opposite the southeastern end of the northeastern boundary of close numbered 784 thence northwestwards to and along the last mentioned boundary to its end thence northeastwards along the middle of Grove's Dam (close numbered 800) and in continuation thereof along the middle of the reservoirs numbered 825 (a), 825 and 830 (3) to the northern end

of the last mentioned reservoir thence northwestwards in a straight line to the southern end of the wall or fence forming the eastern boundary of the premises known as Saint Helen's Sheet Glass Works thence generally northwestwards along the last mentioned boundary to its end thence due north in a straight line to the boundary which divides the parish of Saint John the Evangelist, Ravenhead, from the parish of Saint Helens.

"5. The territory to be annexed to the parish of Sutton :

"(a) All that part (coloured green on the map lettered C annexed hereto) of the parish of Saint John the Evangelist, Ravenhead which lies to the southeast of an imaginary line commencing at a point on the boundary which divides the parish of Saint John the Evangelist, Ravenhead, from the parish of Sutton in the middle of Marshalls Cross Road opposite the northeastern end of the southeastern boundary of the Saint Helens Borough Sanatorium (close numbered 805) and extending thence southwestwards to and along the last mentioned boundary and in continuation thereof in the same straight line to the boundary which divides the parish of Saint John the Evangelist, Ravenhead, from the parish of Sutton.

"(b) All that part (coloured pink on the map lettered D annexed hereto) of the parish of Farnworth which lies to the west and north of an imaginary line commencing at a point on the boundary which divides the parish of Sutton from the parish of Farnworth in the middle of Gorsey Lane opposite to the middle of the northern end of Joy Lane and extending thence southwards to and along the middle of the last mentioned lane and along the middle of Clock Face Road to a point 50 yards southeast of the middle of the northeastern end of Finger House Lane thence first southwestwards and then generally westwards parallel to the middle of the last mentioned lane and Union Lane to the eastern side of Jubit's Lane thence in the same straight line to a point 50 yards west of Jubit's Lane (thereby crossing the last mentioned lane) thence northeastwards parallel to Jubit's Lane to the boundary which divides the parish of Farnworth from the parish of Saint Ann, Rainhill.

"(c) All that part (coloured purple on the map lettered D annexed hereto) of the parish of Saint Ann, Rainhill, which lies to the southeast of an imaginary line commencing at a point on the boundary which divides the parish of Sutton from the parish of Saint Ann, Rainhill, on the southern side of Bell Lane 50 yards to the west of the junction between Bell Lane and Jubit's Lane and extending thence southwestwards parallel to the middle of Jubit's Lane to the boundary which divides the parish of Saint Ann, Rainhill, from the parish of Farnworth.

"6. The territory to be annexed to the parish of Saint Ann, Rainhill :

"(a) All that part (coloured brown on the map lettered D annexed hereto) of the parish of Sutton which lies to the southwest of the middle of Lowfield Lane.

"(b) All that part (coloured blue on the map lettered D annexed hereto) of the parish of Saint Matthew, Thatto Heath, which lies to the south and east of the middle of Two-Butt Lane.

"(c) All that part (coloured green on the map lettered D annexed hereto) of the parish of Farnworth, excluding that part to be annexed to the parish of Sutton under clause 5 (b) of this Scheme, which lies to the northwest of the middle of Jubit's Lane.

"7. The territory to be annexed to the parish of Saint Mark, Saint Helens :

"All those parts (coloured pink on the map lettered E annexed hereto) of the parishes of Saint Mark, Haydock, and Saint Peter, Parr, which lie to the northwest of the middle of the Saint Helens to Wigan line of British Railways (London Midland Region).

"8. The territory to be annexed to the parish of Saint Peter, Parr :

"(a) All that part (coloured pink on the map lettered F annexed hereto) of the parish of Saint Michael, Burton Wood, which lies to the west of an imaginary line commencing at a point on the boundary which divides the parish of Saint Peter, Parr from the parish of Saint Michael, Burton Wood, on the northern side of Broad Lane at the southern end of the footpath from Pennington Lane and extending thence first southwestwards to and then southeastwards along the middle of Broad Lane to the middle
