The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that They have made an Order under sections 3 (6) and 13 of the Import Duties Act, 1958, viz.:

The Import Duties (Temporary Exemptions) (No. 1) Order, 1960, which provides that flat white maize and 6-norchlortetracycline hydrochloride shall be temporarily exempted from import duty under the Import Duties Act, 1958, until 1st April 1960, and 1st October 1960, respectively.

The Order comes into operation on the 3rd February 1960, and has been published as Statutory Instruments 1960, No. 136.

RATES OF INTEREST ON LOCAL LOANS

NOTICE

The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that in pursuance of the powers conferred on them by the Public Works Loans Act, 1897 (60 and 61 Vict. c. '51) as amended by the Public Works Loans Act, 1917 (7 and 8 Geo. 5 c. 32), the Public Works Loans Act, 1918 (8 & 9 Geo. 5 c. 27) and the Housing Act, 1936 (26 Geo. 5 and 1 Edw. 8 c. 51), they have directed by their Minute of the 29th January 1960 that on loans advanced otherwise than on the security of local rates from the Local Loans Fund, on and after the 30th January 1960, there shall be chargeable in lieu of the rates fixed by the Treasury Minute of the 24th October 1958, the following rates of interest: The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury of interest:

Loans to housing associations as defined by the Housing Act, 1936, and the Housing (Scotland) Act, 1950: For any period up to 50 years 57

Loans under the Housing Acts to com-panies and private persons, limiting their profits to the rate for the time being prescribed: For any period up to 40, years

Loans under the Housing Acts to com-panies and private persons, not limiting their profits as aforesaid: For any period up to 40 years 64 IV

Loans under the Harbours and Passing Tolls, etc. Act, 1861, with collateral security: For any period up to 50 years 5%

Loans under the Harbours and Passing Tolls, etc. Act, 1861, without collateral security: For any period up to 50 years 61 All other loans
