Westminster (Adelphi/Whitehall) Smoke Control (Variation) Order, 1960

1. Notice is hereby given that the Mayor, Aldermen and Councillors of the City of Westminster (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act, 1956, on the 24th day of February 1960, made an Order entitled the Westminster (Adelphi/Whitehall) Smoke Control (Variation) Order, 1960 (hereinafter referred to as "the Order") which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

2. The effect of the Order is to exempt from the operation of the Westminster (Adelphi/Whitehall) Smoke Control Order, 1958, certain fireplaces fitted with mechanical stokers installed in (a) Charing Cross Hotel, Strand, and (b) the Royal Commonwealth Society's building, 17-21 Northumberland Avenue, subject to compliance with the conditions set out in the Order.

3. If confirmed the Order will not come into operation before the 1st day of January 1961, or before a later date determined by the Minister of Housing and Local Government.

4. Copies of the Order may be inspected free of charge at Westminster City Hall, Charing Cross Road, London W.C.2, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 11th day of March 1960.

5. Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to the Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.

Smoke Control (Variation) Order, 1960 (hereinafter referred to as "the Order") which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

2. The effect of the Order is to exempt from the operation of the Westminster (Temple Bar) Smoke Control Order, 1957, certain fireplaces fitted with mechanical stokers installed in Australia House, Strand, subject to compliance with the conditions set out in the Order.

3. If confirmed the Order will not come into operation before the 1st day of January 1961, or before a later date determined by the Minister of Housing and Local Government.

4. Copies of the Order may be inspected free of charge at Westminster City Hall, Charing Cross Road, London W.C.2, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 11th day of March 1960.

METROPOLITAN BOROUGH OF HAMMERSMITH

The Hammersmith (No. 2) Smoke Control Order, 1960

1. Notice is hereby given that the Council of the Metropolitan Borough of Hammersmith in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act, 1956, on the 24th day of February 1960, made an Order entitled the Hammersmith (No. 2) Smoke Control Order, 1960, declaring the area described in the schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

2. Subject to the exceptions provided by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £10 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

3. If confirmed the Order will not come into operation before the 1st day of July 1961, or before a later date determined by the Minister of Housing and Local Government.

4. Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at Town Hall, Hammersmith, London W.6, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 11th day of March 1960.

5. Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to The Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.
