ROYAL WARRANT OF PRECEDENCE

The QUEEN has been graciously pleased to ordain and declare that Winifred Anne Grizel Cochrane shall henceforth have, hold and enjoy the title, rank, place, pre-eminence and precedence as the daughter of an Earl which would have been due to her had her father, Douglas Robert Hesketh Roger Cochrane (commonly called the Honourable Douglas Robert Hesketh Roger Cochrane), survived his brother, Thomas Hesketh Douglas Blair, Earl of Dundonald, in the Peerage of Scotland, sometime a Representative Peer for Scotland, and thereby succeeded to the said title and dignity of Earl of Dundonald.

And to command that the said Royal Concession and Declaration be recorded in Her Majesty's College of Arms and in Her Majesty's Lyon Office in Edinburgh.
