#### *The Hampshire (Hartley Wintney Rural District No. 1) Extinguishment Order, 1959*

### HIGHWAYS ACT, 1959

#### COUNTY OF DURHAM

The County Council of Durham hereby give notice that they intend to apply to the Magistrates of the Durham Petty Sessions Division sitting at the Assize Courts, Durham, at 10.30 a.m. on Wednesday, 8th June 1960, for an Order under section 108 of the Highways Act, 1959, authorising the stopping up as unnecessary for the purposes of all traffic of the disused highway at Tursdale in the Parish of Cassop-cum-Quarrington commencing near the northern end of School Street and extending for 550 feet in front of the National Coal Board's Central Workshops and Garage to the southern boundary of the National Coal Board's property.
