AIREBOROUGH URBAN DISTRICT COUNCIL

1. Notice is hereby given that the Aireborough Urban District Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 111 of the Clean Air Act, 1956, on the 2nd day of March 1960, made an Order entitled the Aireborough Urban District (Greenacre Park Rawdon No. 7 and Micklefield Park Rawdon No. 8) Smoke Control Order 1960 declaring the areas described in the schedule hereto to be smoke control areas, which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

2. Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act, if on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to
