

HASTINGS COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Hastings County Borough (London Road and Springfield Road) (No Waiting) Order, 1960

The Hastings County Borough Council propose to make an Order under the Road Traffic Act, 1930, as amended, the effect of which will be to prohibit, save upon the direction or with the consent of a police constable, the waiting of vehicles:

- (a) on the South side of Springfield Road for 50 yards from its junction with London Road,
- (b) between the hours of 8 a.m. and 8 p.m. on the West side of London Road for 157 yards South from its junction with Tower Road West

except for as long as may be necessary:

- (a) for passengers to board or alight,
- (b) for goods to be loaded or unloaded,
- (c) in connexion with any funeral, building operation or demolition, the removal of obstructions to traffic, or the maintenance of the road and public utility services.

HASTINGS COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Hastings County Borough (Town Centre) (Traffic Regulation) No. 1 Order, 1960

The Hastings County Borough Council propose to make an Order under the Road Traffic Act, 1930, as amended, the effect of which will be:

- 1. to make Pelham Street one way from East to West;

- 2. to prohibit, save upon the direction or with the consent of a police constable, the waiting of vehicles:
 - (a) on the lengths of road specified in the first schedule hereto,
 - (b) between 8 a.m. and 8 p.m. on the length of road specified in the second schedule hereto,
 - (c) for more than one hour in three on the length of road specified in the third schedule hereto,

except for as long as may be necessary:

- (a) for passengers to board or alight,
- (b) for goods to be loaded or unloaded,
- (c) in connection with any funeral, building operation or demolition, the removal of obstructions to traffic, or the maintenance of the road and public utility services;

3. to revoke the County Borough Council of Hastings (Traffic Regulation) Order, No. 1, 1938, in so far as it relates to Breeds Place, Caroline Place and Pelham Street.

EAST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of East Sussex (Various Streets, East Grinstead) (Prohibition of Waiting) (No. 1) and (No. 2) Orders, 1960

The East Sussex County Council propose to make two Orders under the Road Traffic Act, 1930, as amended. The effect of the (No. 1) Order will be that the existing waiting restrictions in High Street, Cantelupe Road, King Street, Queen's Road, West Street and Ship Street, East Grinstead will be amended so as to operate between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 6.0 p.m.

The effect of the (No 2) Order will be:

- (i) That the existing waiting restrictions in London Road will be revoked;
- (ii) That with certain exceptions no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 6.0 p.m. in any of the lengths of road specified in the First Schedule hereto; and,
- (iii) That with certain exceptions no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 6.0 p.m. in the length of road specified in the first column of the Second Schedule hereto (a) on the side of the road specified in the second column of the said Second Schedule on those days of the month which bear even numbers; or (b) on the side of the road specified in the third column of the said Second Schedule on those days of the month which bear odd numbers.

Draft Orders and plans showing the lengths of roads concerned are available for inspection during normal office hours at the offices of the Clerk of the East Grinstead Urban District Council, East Court, East Grinstead and at the offices of the undersigned.

Objections to the proposals must be sent in writing to the undersigned by the 28th May 1960.

FIRST SCHEDULE

Lengths of road in the Urban District of East Grinstead

- 1. London Road from its junction with High Street to its junction with Lingfield Road except for a length of the south-west side extending from the junction with Garland Road for a distance of 43 yards south-eastwards.
- 2. De La Warr Road from its junction with Cantelupe Road to its junction with College Lane.
- 3. The North side of Christopher Road from its junction with De La Warr Road westwards to its termination.
- 4. The West side of Cantelupe Road from a point 127 yards north of its junction with High Street northwards to its junction with Christopher Road.
