NATIONAL PARKS AND ACCESS TO THE COUNTRYSIDE ACT, 1949

HAMPSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

*The Hampshire (Alton Rural District No. 21)
Extinguishment Order, 1959*

FLAXTON RURAL DISTRICT COUNCIL

Extinguishment Order*

Any person desiring to question the validity of the definitive map or statement aforesaid on the ground that either is not within the powers of the said Act of 1949, or on the ground that any requirement of the said Act or of any Regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the preparation of the said map or statement or of any draft or provisional map on which the map or statement aforesaid is based, may, within six weeks after the date of publication of this notice, make an application to the High Court in accordance with paragraph 9 of the First Schedule to the said Act of 1949.
