ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

CORNWALL COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Cornwall (Helston) (Traffic Regulation) (Amendment) Order, 1960

On the 2nd May 1960, the Cornwall County Council made an Order under the Road Traffic Act, 1930, as amended, the effect of which is:

- 1. To amend The County of Cornwall (Helston) Traffic Regulation (No. 1) Order, 1948, so that (i) the prohibition of waiting of vehicles in Meneage Street, Helston (B. 3293) between its junction with Wendron Street (A. 394) and its junction with Trengrouse Way (Unclassified District Road) shall not apply in future to the length of the north-east side of that street specified in the Schedule hereto; and (ii) that, save as hereinafter provided, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 9 a.m. and 6 p.m. on weekdays on the length of the north-east side of the said street specified in the Schedule hereto
 - (a) for a longer period than twenty minutes, or (b) if a period of less than forty minutes has elapsed since the termination during the said hours of the last period of waiting (if any) of the vehicle on that side of the said length of road.

Exceptions are provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for so'long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from the vehicle; to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle; to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic or the maintenance of the said length of the north-east side of the said street or of the services therein; or to enable the vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage situated on or adjacent to the said length of the north-east side of the said street; and in connection with a funeral.

2. To amend The County of Cornwall (Helston) Traffic Regulation (Nos. 1 & 2) Orders, 1948, and The County of Cornwall (Helston) (Traffic Regulation) (Amendment) Order, 1954, so as to extend for

a further distance of 23 yards in a westerly direction the existing length of the north side of Coinagehall Street, Helston, upon which the waiting of vehicles is prohibited, with a consequent reduction by 23 yards of the length of the north side of that street upon which unilateral waiting restrictions were previously in operation.

3. To amend The County of Cornwall (Helston) Traffic Regulation (Nos. 1 & 2) Orders, 1948, so that nothing in those Orders shall prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road referred to in those Orders for so long as may be necessary in connection with a funeral.

The Order comes into operation on the 15th June 1960.

Meneage Street (B. 3293)—north-east side—between a point 60 yards south-east of its junction with Wendron Street and a point 20 yards northwest of its junction with Trengrouse Way.
