FLINTSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Flint (Prohibition of Waiting) (Central Beach Area, Prestatyn) Order, 1950

The Flintshire County Council propose to make an Order under the Road Traffic Act, 1930, as amended the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting by vehicles (subject to certain exceptions) from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. from the 1st April until the 30th September (both inclusive) in each year in the following roads in the Urban District of Prestatyn:

- (a) No Waiting will be permitted in Beach Road West, Third Avenue, First Avenue, The Mall, Beach Road East from its junction with Bastion Road to a point 598 yards east thereof, Beach Close, the westerly side of Bastion Road from Beach Road West to the southerly boundary of Carr Holm and the easterly side of Bastion Road from Beach Road East to a point 133 yards south thereof.
- (b) Waiting limited to 20 minutes in any hour on the easterly side of Bastion Road from a point 133 yards south of Beach Road East to a point opposite the southerly boundary of Carr Holm.

CITY AND COUNTY OF NEWCASTLE UPON TYNE

The City and County of Newcastle upon Tyne Ellison Place (One-Way) Order, 1960

On the 3rd day of May 1960, the Council of the City and County of Newcastle upon Tyne made an Order under the Road Traffic Act, 1930, as amended, the effect of which will be to prohibit any person from driving or causing or permitting to be driven any vehicle on the length of road specified in the first column of the Schedule hereto, otherwise than in the direction specified opposite to such length in the second column of the said Schedule.
