

members of the Naval Nursing Auxiliary Section of Queen Alexandra's Royal Naval Nursing Service who

- (a) enter the service on or after 1st July, 1949; or
(b) re-enter the service, after a break in service, on or after 1st July, 1949; except those who re-enter within twelve months of being invalided or those who have already been granted service retired pay or service pension before re-entry.

Any rating or other rank the regular part of whose engagement terminated before 1st July, 1949, but who continued to serve on the reserve portion of that regular engagement shall, if he rejoined the service on a regular engagement before the termination of the reserve portion of his previous regular engagement, be regarded as having continuous regular service for the purpose of this Clause.

"49. The Admiralty may exempt from the provisions of this Section any rating or other rank who entered or re-entered the Royal Navy after 30th June, 1949, if satisfied that such entry or re-entry was in fulfilment of an undertaking or commitment entered into before 1st July, 1949.

"50. Except as provided in Clause 51 service pension granted to a pensioned rating or other rank shall be reduced by 4d. a week for each complete year of reckonable service, subject to a maximum of 16s. 0d. a week, on becoming eligible for a National Retirement Pension on attaining the age of 65, in the case of men, or on attaining the age of 60 in the case of women.

"51. No abatement, however, shall be made in the case of a person permanently resident outside the United Kingdom, unless that person is receiving retirement pension under the National Insurance Act, 1946, or of a corresponding award payable under reciprocal arrangements with the country of domicile."

Her Majesty, having taken the said Memorial into consideration, was pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to approve of what is therein proposed.

And the Right Honourable the Lords Commissioners of the Admiralty are to give the necessary directions herein accordingly.

Whereas the Church Commissioners have duly prepared and laid before Her Majesty in Council a Scheme bearing date the 29th day of April, 1960, in the words and figures following, that is to say:—

"We, the Church Commissioners, acting in pursuance of the New Parishes Measure, 1943, have prepared and humbly lay before Your Majesty in Council the following Scheme for (1) constituting a new parish to be taken out of the parishes of Saint Peter, Aldborough Hatch; Saint Chad, Chadwell Heath; The Ascension, Collier Row, Romford; and Saint John, Romford; and (2) altering the boundaries of the parishes of Saint Peter, Aldborough Hatch; Saint Chad, Chadwell Heath and Saint John, Romford; all of which parishes are in the diocese of Chelmsford.

"SCHEME

"Whereas

"(1) we, the Church Commissioners, are satisfied (a) that the spiritual interests of the area defined in Part I of the subjoined Schedule and delineated on the map hereto annexed would be best served by constituting it a new parish and that a suitable endowment thereof will be provided; and (b) that it is desirable that the boundaries of the parishes of Saint Peter, Aldborough Hatch; Saint Chad, Chadwell Heath; and Saint John, Romford should be altered in the manner described in Part II of the said Schedule and delineated on the said map; and

"(2) we have not approved any consecrated church within the area as suitable to be the parish church of the new parish:

"Now, therefore, with the consent of the Right Reverend Falkner, Bishop of Chelmsford, (in testimony whereof he has executed this Scheme) we, the said Church Commissioners, do humbly recommend and propose as follows, that is to say:—

"1. *Constitution of New District.*

"(a) As from the date of the licence thereto of a Minister the area defined in Part I of the subjoined Schedule and delineated on the map hereto annexed shall be a separate district for spiritual purposes.

"(b) As from the date of the consecration of a church within the area approved by us, the said Church Commissioners, as suitable to be a parish church, or if the church is consecrated before such approval the date of the approval, the said area shall become a new parish.

"(c) The name of the district (or parish as the case may be) shall be 'The District (or Parish) of Saint Mark, Marks Gate, Chadwell Heath'.

"2. *Archdeaconry and Rural Deanery.*

"The said district or parish shall be in the Archdeaconry of West Ham and in the rural deanery of Chafford.

"3. *Alteration of Boundaries.*

"As from the day of the date of the publication in the *London Gazette* of any Order of Your Majesty in Council confirming this Scheme, the boundaries of the said parishes of Saint Peter, Aldborough Hatch; Saint Chad, Chadwell Heath; and Saint John, Romford shall be altered in the manner described in Part II of the said Schedule and delineated on the map hereto annexed.

"THE SCHEDULE

"Part I

"The area (coloured pink on the map annexed hereto) of the new district of Saint (Mark, Marks Gate, Chadwell Heath, comprising:

"(a) all that part of the parish of Saint Peter, Aldborough Hatch, which lies to the south of the middle of Billet Road, the east of the middle of Hainault Road and the north of the middle of Eastern Avenue;

"(b) all that part of the parish of The Ascension, Collier Row, Romford, which lies to the south of (i) the middle of Billet Road, and (ii) an imaginary line joining the eastern end of the middle of Billet Road to the middle of the western end of the approach road or track in close No. 110 leading to close No. 100, continuing northeastwards along the middle of the said approach road or track and the middle of the road or track running approximately through the middle of close No. 100, continuing thence in a straight line across close No. 98 to the southwestern corner of close No. 98a and along the southern boundary of close No. 98a to the boundary between the parishes of The Ascension, Collier Row, Romford, and Saint John, Romford;

"(c) all that part of the parish of Saint Chad, Chadwell Heath, which lies to the north of the middle of Eastern Avenue; and

"(d) all that part of the parish of Saint John, Romford, which lies to the north of the middle of Eastern Avenue and to the west of an imaginary line starting at a point in the middle of Eastern Avenue opposite to the eastern boundary of close No. 463, proceeding northwards along the last mentioned boundary, eastwards along the southern boundary of close No. 454, northwards along the eastern boundary of the last mentioned close to the northeastern corner of the said close, thence in a straight line to join the southeastern corner of close No. 114 on the boundary which divides the parish of Saint John, Romford, from the parish of The Ascension, Collier Row, Romford.

"Part II

"The territory to be annexed to the parish of Saint Chad, Chadwell Heath:

"(a) all that part of the parish of Saint Peter, Aldborough Hatch, (coloured green on the map annexed hereto) which lies to the east and northeast of the middle of Chadwell Heath Lane, the east of the middle of Barley Lane and the south of the middle of Eastern Avenue; and

"(b) all that part of the parish of Saint John, Romford, (coloured brown on the map annexed hereto) which lies to the south of the middle of Eastern Avenue and the west of an imaginary line commencing at a point where the southern end of the hedge dividing close No. 468 joins the boundary dividing the parishes of Saint Chad, Chadwell Heath, and Saint John, Romford, continuing northwards along the line of the said hedge and in a straight line in continuation thereof to the middle of Eastern Avenue."
