The Minister of Labour hereby gives notice that on 26th July 1960 he made the Work in Compressed Air (Amendment) Regulations, 1960 (S.I. 1960 No. 1307) under Sections 46 and 60 of the Factories Act, 1937 and Section 8 of the Factories Act, 1948.

These Regulations extend the scope of the Work in Compressed Air (Special Regulations, 1958), so as to make them apply not only to work in compressed air carried out in works of engineering construction but also to work in compressed air carried out in any factory and in any other premises or place to which the Factories Act, 1937, applies.
