

(b) for the construction by the Minister of a new road in the said Rural District;

(c) for the stopping up of two lengths of the Newport — Monmouth — Ross-on-Wye — Worcester Trunk Road in the said Rural District;

(d) that the Herefordshire County Council shall become the highway authority for the new road on the date on which notice is given by the Minister to the Council that the new road is opened for through traffic.

## LAND DRAINAGE ACT, 1930 RIVER BOARDS ACT, 1948

### Bramcote Brook Internal Drainage District
