Subject to the exemptions provided by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £10 unless an offence and hable to a fine not exceeding £10 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

3. If confirmed the Order will not come into operation before the 1st August 1961 or before a later date determined by the Minister of Housing and Local Covernment.

4. Copies of the Order and of the Map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Lewisham Town Hall, Catford, London S.E.6 at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 12th day of August 1960.

5. Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by Notice in writing to The Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.
