BOROUGH OF HARROW

The Borough of Harrow Smoke Control (No. 1) Order, 1960

1. Notice is hereby given that the Council of the Borough of Harrow in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act, 1956, on the 22nd day of July 1960, made an Order entitled *The Borough of Harrow Smoke Control (No. 1) Order, 1960*, declaring the area described in the schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

2. By virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act, if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £10 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuels other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

3. If confirmed, the Order will come into operation on 1st September 1961, or on such later date as may be determined by the Minister of Housing and Local Government.

4. Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the office of the Town Clerk, Borough of Harrow, Harrow Weald Lodge, Harrow, Middlesex, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 11th day of August 1960.

5. Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to the Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.

SCHEDULE

The area comprises (i) approximately 45 acres to the south of the London Midland and West Regions Railway lines, and (ii) a rectangular area of approximately 180 acres bounded by Eastcote Lane on the north, by Alexandra Avenue on the east, and by the boundaries with Ruislip—Northwood Urban District and the Borough of Ealing on the west and south respectively, the whole area totalling approximately 225 acres, with 2,179 dwellings and other premises as detailed below.
