BOROUGH OF EDMONTON

The Edmonton No. 3 Smoke Control Order, 1960

1. Notice is hereby given that the Edmonton Borough Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 111 of the Clean Air Act, 1956, on the 29th day of July 1960, made an Order entitled The Edmonton No. 3 Smoke Control Order, 1960, declaring the Area described in the Schedule hereto to be a Smoke Control Area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

2. Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 111 (4) of the Act, if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the Smoke Control Area, the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £10 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

3. Copies of the Order and the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Town Hall, Edmonton, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 12th day of August 1960.

4. Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to the Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.

SCHEDULE

That part of the Borough of Edmonton bounded by a line commencing at the junction of Church Street and Victoria Road and proceeding westwards along the centre of Church Street to the Great Cambridge Road thence turning southwards along the centre of that road to Westerham Avenue, thence turning eastwards along the centre of that road to Haselbury Road, thence turning southwards along the centre of that road to Park Lane, thence turning eastwards along the centre of that road to Victoria Road, thence turning northwards along the centre of that road to Church Street, as shown coloured green on the map referred to in the Order.

ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

DEVON COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Devon (Various Streets, Ilfracombe) (Prohibition of Waiting) (Amendment) Order, 1960

On the 29th July 1960, the Devon County Council made an Order under the Road Traffic Act, 1930, as amended, the effect of which is to amend the County

of Devon (Various Streets, Ilfracombe) (Prohibition of Waiting and One-Way) Order, 1958, by extending the dates during which waiting by vehicles is prohibited in St. James Place, Ropery Road, Fore Street, The Quay, Broad Street and Sommers Crescent.

The proposed amendment prohibits waiting by vehicles, subject to certain exceptions, from 1st June to 30th September in every year (instead of from 1st July to 31st August).
