A copy of the confirmed Order and the map contained in it has been deposited at, and may be inspected free of charge, at the Council Offices, Pallant House, Chichester, between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. Monday to Friday and between 9 a.m. and 12 noon on Saturday.

The Order becomes operative as from the 5th day of August 1960, but if any person aggrieved by the

Order desires to question the validity thereof or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act, 1959, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act or any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the approval of the Order he may, within six weeks from the date of publication of this notice, make application to the High Court.
