SONNING CORN RENTS

To Whom it may concern :

In the Matter of an Act of Parliament passed in the Fifty Sixth year of the reign of His late Majesty King George the Third entitled "An Act for Inclosing lands in the Parish of Sonning in the Counties of Berks and Oxford".

Take Notice that an application will be made by the Church Commissioners for England (in whom the Corn Rents formerly payable to the Vicar of Sonning are now vested by virtue of the Tithe Act, 1925, and the Church Commissioners Measure, 1947) at the Quarter Sessions of the Peace to be held in and for the County of Berks on the Twenty sixth day of September 1960, or at an adjournment of such Sessions for the nomination and appointment of Three persons as Referees for enquiring into and ascertaining the average price of a Winchester Bushel of good marketable wheat within the said County of Berks for the term of seven years then last past, to the intent that the amount of the Corn Rents may be re-ascertained and declared pursuant to the first above-mentioned Act.
