LEICESTER CITY COUNCIL

The Leicester (Traffic Regulation) Order, 1960

A Public Inquiry will be held by Mr. H. Hopkins at the Town Hall, Leicester, on Thursday the 1st day of September 1960, at 10 a.m., to consider the proposal of the Leicester City Council to make an Order under the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be to:

- (1) prohibit waiting by vehicles in lengths of road as indicated in the First Schedule hereto;
- (2) prohibit waiting by vehicles between 8.30 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on week-days on other lengths of road, on different sides on alternate days as indicated in the Third Schedule hereto and so that, where waiting is not otherwise prohibited, a vehicle is not to wait:
 - (a) in the streets specified in Part One of that Schedule for a longer period than thirty minutes nor until thirty minutes have elapsed since the last period of permitted waiting, and
 - (b) in the street specified in Part Two of that Schedule for a longer period than forty minutes nor until eighty minutes have elapsed since the last period of permitted waiting;
- (3) require vehicles to be driven on lengths of road in one direction only as indicated in the Second Schedule hereto, but exempting therefrom mechanical road cleansing vehicles between 11 p.m. on one day and 7 a.m. on the following day;
- (4) exempt from the prohibitions waiting by a vehicle for persons to board or alight therefrom, or in connection with building operations, demolitions, removal of traffic obstructions, or maintenance of roads or services therein:
- (5) also exempt from the prohibitions waiting by a vehicle for loading or unloading of goods but except in the case of postal vehicles no vehicle is to wait:
 - (a) in the lengths of road mentioned in Part Two of the First Schedule hereto for a longer period than one hour, nor until twenty minutes have elapsed since the last period of permitted waiting, outside the same premises, and for this purpose the whole area occupied by market stalls constitutes the same premises, or
 - (b) for any other length of road affected for a longer period than twenty minutes in any hour, nor until forty minutes have elapsed since the last period of permitted waiting outside the same premises;
- (6) revoke the requirements of the Leicester (Traffic Regulation) (Consolidation) Order, 1956, and the Leicester (Traffic Regulation) (Rutland Street) Order, 1957 (which are to be consolidated with amendments with further requirements in the proposed Order).

(7) to define for the purpose of all waiting prohibitions "Week day" as any day of the week except Sunday Any person interested is entitled to be heard in person or by counsel, solicitor or agent and any person, whether he intends to appear at the inquiry or not may forward any objection to the proposal to Mr. H. Hopkins at the under-mentioned address or at the place at which the inquiry is to be held.
