FACTORIES ACTS, 1937 TO 1959

In pursuance of section 129 of the Factories Act, 1937, and the Second Schedule to that Act, the Minister of Labour hereby gives notice that he proposes to make a code of special regulations imposing requirements for the health, safety and welfare of persons employed in shipbuilding and ship-repairing. When these proposed regulations come into operation the Shipbuilding Regulations, 1931, made under section 79 of the Factory and Workshop Act, 1901, will be revoked.
