The County Borough of Merthyr Tydfil (Various Streets) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1960

The Merthyr Tydfil County Borough Council propose to make an Order under the Road Traffic Act, 1930, as amended, the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles on the lengths of road specified in the first column of the Schedule on the side or sides indicated in the second column of the scid Schedule. of the said Schedule.

Nothing in the proposed Order shall prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road referred to for so long as may be necessary:

(a) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
(b) to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle; or
(c) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently
