

SOMERSET COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Somerset (Borough of Chard—Various Streets) Prohibition of Waiting and Restricted Waiting (No. 1) Order, 1960.

The Somerset County Council propose to make an Order under the Road Traffic Act, 1930, as amended, the effect of which will be (1) to prohibit with certain exceptions the waiting of vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. and 8 p.m. on the lengths of road specified in the first schedule hereto; and (2) to prohibit with certain exceptions the waiting of vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. for a longer period than one hour in any two hours on the lengths of road specified in the second schedule hereto.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road referred to for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from such vehicle, to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle, or to enable the vehicle if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any funeral, building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or the services therein, or to enable the vehicle to take in petrol etc. from any garage situated on or adjacent to any of the said lengths of road.

A copy of the draft Order and a plan showing the lengths of road affected may be inspected at the office of the Town Clerk of Chard, Municipal Offices, Chard, Somerset, or at County Hall, Taunton.

FIRST SCHEDULE

East Street (Class 1 Road) A.30

From its junction with Furnham Road to the east side of Tapstone lane.

Boden Street (District Road)

From its junction with Fore Street to a point approximately 80 yards south of that junction.

Combe Street (Class 3 Road)

From its junction with Fore Street and High Street (A.30) at the Post Office cross roads to a point 150 yards north west of that cross roads.

SECOND SCHEDULE

High Street and Fore Street (Class 1 Road) A.30

From a point approximately 190 yards west of Holyrood Street (B.3162) to a point approximately 50 yards west of Silver Street A.358.

KIDDERMINSTER BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Kidderminster (Parts of Green Street) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1960

The Kidderminster Borough Council propose to make an Order under the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles in Green Street between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m.:

- (i) on both sides, between its junction with Worcester Cross and a point 30 yards south-west of that junction;
- (ii) on both sides, between a point 123 yards south-west of its junction with Worcester Cross and a point 173 yards south-west of that junction;
- (iii) on both sides, between a point 17 yards north-east of its junction with Dixon Street and a point 27 yards south-west of that junction;
- (iv) on the north-west side, between a point 257 yards south-west of its junction with Dixon Street and a point 303 yards south-west of that junction.

The Borough of Kidderminster (Part of Mill Street) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1960

The Kidderminster Borough Council propose to make an Order under the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be to revoke the existing unilateral waiting restrictions and to prohibit the waiting of vehicles in Mill Street from its junction with Bull Ring and Pitts Lane to a point 70 yards north-west of that junction between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m.
