"SCHEDULE IV

SPECIAL SERVICE PAY

"Special Service Pay at the standard and training rates shown in paragraph 5 will be paid to personnel (including Special Duties List Officers) in the following categories:—

- (A) training to qualify in flying duties ;
 (B) qualified in flying duties and either filling, or liable to be called upon to fill, an active flying appointment ;
 (C) qualified for service in submarines and appointed as part crew or spare crew or 'for duty with submarines' (officers will be appointed 'for duty with submarines' only when they are qualified submarine officers and are required as part of their normal duties to go to sea in submarines from time to time);
 (D) appointed to the Surveying Service ;
 (E) training to qualify as parachutists ;
 (F) qualified as parachutists and serving in parachute units with a continuing liability for parachute duties ;
 (G) qualified in Diving Duties and employed thereon or keeping in practice to meet liability to be so employed if called upon.

Commencement of Special Service Pay

"2. Payment of Special Service Pay will begin on the date of appointment, drafting or posting for the duties concerned ; or in the case of Category (G) from the date of qualification.

"3. Subject to the conditions of paragraph 4 Special Service Pay will remain in issue continuously, during periods of leave (including terminal and invaliding leave) time on passage, courses or between appointments and irrespective of the nature of the duties on which the officer or man is actually engaged at any particular time.

Cessation or Suspension of Special Service Pay.

"4. Special Service Pay will cease or be suspended, as the case may be, under the following conditions:—

- (a) For personnel who become medically unfit to carry out the duties for which the allowance is

being paid, for reasons beyond their own control—

(i) All categories except (B)—as from 91 days from the date on which they were first checked sick, or until they take up other duties carrying no entitlement to Special Service Pay, whichever is earlier ;

(ii) Category (B)—as from 12 months from the date on which they were first checked sick, or, if they are to be permanently grounded, on the date on which they are appointed for non-flying duties, whichever is earlier.

(b) For personnel who become medically unfit to carry out the duties for which the allowance is being paid, for reasons within their own control—as from the date on which they were first checked sick.

(c) For personnel reverted to General Service or taking up other duties carrying no entitlement to Special Service Pay—

(i) All categories except (B)—as from the date of reversion to General Service or change of duty.

(ii) Category (B)—after a period of 2½ years from the date of reversion, or until they are permanently reverted to the General Service or permanently grounded, whichever is earlier.

During this period Captains and Commanders will receive a lower rate of Special Service Pay (Rate V).

(d) For personnel in Category (B) who are grounded for disciplinary reasons—as from the date of grounding.

(e) For personnel who fail to maintain a proper standard of efficiency in the duties for which Special Service Pay is being paid—as from the date of such failure.

"5. The daily rates of Special Service Pay are to be as follows:—
