Extinction of Public Rights of Way City of Plymouth

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Housing and Local Government, in exercise of powers conferred upon him by section 23 of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1944, as incorporated with the Town and Country Planning Act, 1947, has prepared in draft and proposes to make an Order extinguishing the public rights of way over part of Windsor Place, Plymouth.

Copies of the draft Order and of the map relative thereto showing the land over which the rights of way proposed to be extinguished subsist may be inspected at the Town Clerk's Office, Pounds House, Plymouth, without payment of fee during usual office hours.

Any objection to this proposal must be made in writing, and addressed to the Minister of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, before the 2nd day of December 1960.

The Minister is not, in all cases, required to cause a local inquiry to be held. It is important, therefore, that an objection should include a full statement in writing of the grounds on which the objection is made, as the objector may have no further opportunity to make such a statement.

Town and Country Planning Act, 1947

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 49 of the above Act entitled "The Stopping up of Highways (County of Surrey) (No. 10) Order, 1960" authorising the stopping up of a length of footpath at Summers Road (known locally as Summers Lane), Godalming, Surrey, and requiring the provision of a new footpath.

Town and Country Planning Act, 1947

Mineral Workings Act, 1951

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 49 of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1947, and section 32 of the Mineral Workings Act, 1951, authorising the permanent stopping up of a length of road at Pembrey, Carmarthenshire, and the continued temporary stopping up for a period of one year of a further length of the same road, in order to enable development, consisting of the working of opencast coal and other minerals, to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted under Part III of the 1947 Act.
