

SWANSCOMBE URBAN DISTRICT COUNCIL

Swanscombe Urban District Council, Station Road, Greenhithe, Public Path Diversion Order, 1960

The above Order made on the 15th day of November 1960, is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Its effect will be to divert the public right of way leading from a point on Station Road for a distance of approximately 100 feet in a westerly direction to a point 190 feet south and then running in a westerly direction for approximately 100 feet and then running in a northerly direction for a distance of approximately 115 feet to connect with the existing footpath at the point of diversion.

Macclesfield Rural District Council (Alder Wood, Over Alderley) Footpath Diversion Order, 1960

RURAL DISTRICT COUNCIL OF CHELMSFORD

Rural District Council of Chelmsford (Ingatestone and Fryerning) Public Path Diversion Order, 1960

The above Order made on the 25th day of October 1960 is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Its effect will be to divert the public right of way running from Hall Lane in the Parish of Ingatestone and Fryerning in a general easterly direction to a point on the public highway in the vicinity of St. Mary's Church, Buttsbury in the Parish of Stock, namely that part of the said path which runs through O.S. Enclosures Nos. 221 and 218 North of Ingatestone Hall in the Parish of Ingatestone and Fryerning so that instead of running in a generally straight line through those enclosures from the point of entry into Enclosure No. 221 to the point of exit from Enclosure No. 218 the path will follow a route South of the present line running in a South-easterly direction from the present point of commencement in field No. 221 for a distance of approximately 780 ft. to a point in Enclosure No. 218 and thence in an easterly direction for approximately 730 ft. through that enclosure to the present point of exit therefrom.
