## BOROUGH OF ALDEBURGH

*Borough of Aldeburgh (Kings Field Footpath) Public  
Path Diversion Order, 1960*

The above Order made on the 21st day of November 1960, is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Its effect will be to divert the public right of way running from a point 50 feet or thereabouts West of the Public Shelter situate in Kings Field, Aldeburgh, in a South Easterly direction for a distance of 490 feet to the North East corner of the allotments situate in the said Kings Field to a line running from a point 50 feet or thereabouts West of the said Public Shelter in a South Easterly direction for a distance of 150 feet to the eastern boundary wall of the said Kings Fields to a point some 40 feet West of the Boy Scout Headquarters situate in the said Kings Field and thence in a Southerly direction along the Western side of the said boundary wall for a distance of 390 feet to the North East corner of the said allotments.
