URBAN DISTRICT COUNCIL OF RUNCORN

The Runcorn Urban District Council (Church Street (A533)—King Street to High Street (A533)) (Unilateral Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1960

On the 5th day of December 1960, the Runcorn Urban District Council made an Order under the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which is to institute unilateral waiting by vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on alternate sides of Church Street (A533) between King Street and High Street (A533) including the restriction that vehicles shall not wait for more than thirty minutes in any consecutive period of two hours on the side of the road where vehicles are not prohibited from time to time, except for the purpose of boarding, alighting, loading, unloading, building and road works, the maintenance of essential services and funeral corteges with effect from the 19th December 1960.
