PUBLIC HEALTH ACTS AND CLEAN AIR ACT

BOROUGH OF WILLESDEN

The No. 3 (Church End and Roundwood) Smoke Control Order, 1960

1. The authorised fuels include, anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity. 3. If confirmed the Order will come into force on the November 1961 or a later date determined
