PUBLIC HEALTH ACTS
AND CLEAN AIR ACT

BOROUGH OF WILLESDEN

The No. 3 (Church End and Roundwood) Smoke Control Order, 1960

1. Notice is hereby given that the Corporation of Willesden, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 111 of the Clean Air Act, 1956, on the 22nd day of November 1960, made an Order entitled the No. 3 (Church End and Roundwood) Smoke Control Order, 1960, declaring the area described in the schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

2. Subject to the exemptions provided by virtue of section 111 (4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £10 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include, anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

3. If confirmed the Order will come into force on the 1st November 1961 or a later date determined by the Minister of Housing and Local Government.

4. Copies of the Order (and of the map referred to therein) may be inspected free of charge at the Town Hall, Dyne Road, Kilburn, London N.W.6, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 27th day of December 1960.

5. Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to The Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.
