

(d) to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with furniture deliveries or removals, or funerals.

3. The Interpretation Act, 1889, shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

4. This Order shall come into operation on the 1st day of February 1961, and may be cited as the Borough of Sutton Coldfield (Various Streets) Traffic Regulation Order, No. 2, 1961.

**SUTTON COLDFIELD BOROUGH COUNCIL**

*Borough of Sutton Coldfield (Manor Hill)  
Traffic Regulation Order, 1961*

The Council of the Borough of Sutton Coldfield in exercise of their powers under sub-sections (1) (2) and (3) of section 26 and sub-section (4) of section 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, and of all other

powers them enabling in that behalf hereby make the following Order:

1. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on any of the lengths of road specified in the First column of the Schedule to this Order otherwise than in the direction specified opposite the said length in the Second column of the said Schedule.

2. The Interpretation Act, 1889, shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. This Order shall come into operation on the 1st day of February 1961, and may be cited as the Borough of Sutton Coldfield (Manor Hill) Traffic Regulation Order, 1961.

**BOROUGH OF BEDFORD**

*The Borough of Bedford (Various Streets—Area No. 5) (Prohibition of Waiting and Restricted Waiting) Order, 1961*  
On the 23rd January 1961 the Bedford Borough Council made an Order under the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which, with the usual exceptions, will be as follows, namely:

1. To prohibit waiting between 8.0 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on week-days in the lengths of road specified in the first Schedule hereto.
2. To limit waiting to one hour periods on week-days between 8.0 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. in the lengths of road specified in the second Schedule hereto.

A copy of the Order and a map showing the roads affected may be inspected free of charge at the Town Clerk's Office, Town Hall, Bedford, during the usual office hours.

The Order will come into operation on the 1st February 1961.
