(d) to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with furniture deliveries or removals, or funerals.

- 3. The Interpretation Act, 1889, shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an IAct of Parliament.
- 4. This Order shall come into operation on the 1st day of February 1961, and may be cited as the Borough of Sutton Coldfield (Various Streets) Traffic Regulation Order, No. 2, 1961.
