## BERKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

*The Royal County of Berkshire (Denmark Street, Wokingham) (No Waiting) Order, 1961*

On the 10th February 1961, the Berkshire County Council made an Order under the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which is to prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in Denmark Street (A.321) Wokingham, from the Market Place to the junction with Wellington Road.

Exceptions are included in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from the vehicle, to enable the vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or air, to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle, or to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any funeral, building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or the services therein.

The Order is operative from 15th February 1961.

## NORTHAMPTON COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

*The County Borough Council of Northampton (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) (No. 1) Order, 1961*
