The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that They have made an Order under Sections 9 and 13 of, and the Fifth Schedule to, the Import Duties Act, 1958, viz.:

The Import Duty Drawbacks (No. 4) Order, 1961.

This Order provides for the allowance of drawback of import duty on the exportation of—

- (a) blades and heads, and base metal parts of blades and heads, for electric shavers;
- (b) certain men's and women's garments made from specified imported silk fabric;
- (c) certain women's and girls' garments made from fabric or silk or man-made fibres or both;

and consolidates the existing provisions relating to drawback on silk, man-made fibres, and manufactures of silk or man-made fibres.

This Order comes into operation on 19th April 1961, and has been published as Statutory Instruments 1961, No. 702.
