

GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The Gloucestershire County Council (Oxford Street, Lydney) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1961

The Gloucestershire County Council propose to make an Order under section 26 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles on that length of Oxford Street, Lydney, which extends from its junction with High Street (Trunk Road A.48) in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 90 yards.

The Order will not prohibit vehicles from waiting for so long as is necessary (a) to enable a person to board or alight or to enable goods to be loaded or unloaded; (b) to enable the vehicles to be used in connection with any building, demolition, highway or specified public utility operations.

GLOUCESTER CITY COUNCIL

The City of Gloucester (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) (No. 1) Order, 1961

The Gloucester City Council have applied to the Minister of Transport for confirmation of an Order made by them under the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be to impose a 40 m.p.h. speed limit on each of the undermentioned lengths of roads:

1. Gloucester Ring Road (Route A.38) comprising Eastern Avenue, Finlay Road, Southern Avenue and Cole Avenue.
2. Bristol Road (Route A.430) from a point 120 yards south of its junction with Tuffley Lane to the Gloucester City boundary.
3. Painswick Road (Route B.4073) from a point 63 yards south east of Matson Lane to the Gloucester City boundary.

CORNWALL COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Cornwall (New Bridge Street, Truro) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1961

The Cornwall County Council propose to make an Order under the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on weekdays on New Bridge Street, Truro (Class III) between its junction with Duke Street and its junction with St. Austell Street, a distance of 133 yards.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order to allow a vehicle to wait in the said length of road for so long as may be necessary to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle; to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle; to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic or the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said length of road or of the services therein; to enable the vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage situate on or adjacent to the said length of road; and in connection with a funeral.

Objections to the proposals must be sent in writing to the undersigned by the 29th May 1961.

A copy of the proposed Order, together with a plan showing the length of road referred to therein, will be available for inspection during normal office hours at the County Hall, Truro.

CORNWALL COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Cornwall (Carnanton) (Prohibition of Waiting) (Amendment) Order, 1960

On the 26th April 1961, the Cornwall County Council made an Order under the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which is to amend the County of Cornwall (Carnanton) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1959, so that as from the 26th April 1961, the length of the St. Columb to Newquay Road (Route A. 3059) on which the waiting of vehicles is, with certain exceptions, prohibited shall be extended by 350 yards to the west and 50 yards to the east; and so that there shall be additional exceptions in respect of the whole of the restricted length of this road as now extended to allow the waiting of vehicles thereon for so long as may be necessary to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle and to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicles.

CORNWALL COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Cornwall (Daglands Road, Fowey) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1961

The Cornwall County Council propose to make an Order under the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles between the hours of 9 a.m. and 6 p.m. daily during the period from 1st June to 30th September (both dates inclusive) in each year on that length of Daglands Road, Fowey (Unclassified District Road) between its junctions with Lostwithiel Street and The Esplanade.
