##### *Direction as to land at Ashley, Box*

Notice is hereby given "that the Wiltshire County Council have directed in respect of 28.96 acres of land at Ashley, Box in the County of Wilts., being Parcel Nos. 466 (pt) 467 and 468 on the Ordnance

Survey for Wilts. Sheet XXV. 9, 10, 13, and 14 (Editions of 1939, 1936, 1936 and 1939 respectively) that the permission granted by Article 3 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order, 1950 as amended shall not apply to any development of the kind specified in para. 1 of Class VI of the First Schedule to said Order which consists of the erection of any building to be used for the production of poultry (which word is, for the avoidance of doubt, expressed to include turkeys) including the breeding, hatching, sexing, rearing, killing, plucking or dressing of poultry or the keeping of poultry for the production of eggs where the ground area covered by such building exceeds 500 square feet either by itself or after the addition thereto of the ground area covered by any existing building or buildings (other than a dwellinghouse) erected on the same agricultural unit or in course of erection within the preceding two years".

The effect of this direction, subject to approval by the Minister of Housing and Local Government, will be that from the date of first publication of this notice any persons wishing to erect a building or buildings of a size specified in the direction for poultry or egg production on the land described in the direction will be obliged to apply for planning permission under Part III of the Act of 1947.

A copy of a plan defining the area to which the direction relates may be inspected at County Hall, Trowbridge at all reasonable hours.
