MONMOUTHSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Monmouth (Llanarth Road, Pontllanfraith) (Unilateral Waiting) Order, 1961

On the 1st May 1961, the Monmouthshire County Council made an Order under the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which is that:

No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 12 noon and 11 p.m., in the length of road specified in the first column of the Schedule hereto:

- (a) on the side of the road specified opposite that length of road in the second column of the said Schedule on those days of the month which bear even numbers; or
- (b) on the side of the road specified opposite that length of road in the third column of the said Schedule on those days of the month which bear odd numbers; or
- (c) on the side of that length of road on which vehicles are not for the time being prohibited from waiting by paragraph (a) or (b) of this Article-
 - (i) for a longer period than thirty minutes; or
 - (ii) if a period of less than thirty minutes has elapsed since the termination during the said hours of the last period of waiting (if any) of the vehicles on that side.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from the vehicle, to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle, to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, and the maintenance of the road or the services therein, or to enable a vehicle to be used as part of a funeral cortege or otherwise in connection with a funeral.

The County Borough of Bolton (Various Streets) (Prohibition of Waiting) (No. 1) Order, 1961

The Bolton County Borough Council propose to make an Order under section 26 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles between 8.30 a.m. and 6 p.m. on any day other than Sunday in the following lengths of road:

Deansgate:

(i) The north side from a point 138 feet west of its junction with Knowsley Street to its junction with Bank Street;
(ii) The south side from a point 74 feet west of its junction with Howell Croft North to its

junction with Bradshawgate;

Howell Croft North:

(i) The west side from its junction with Deans-gate to its junction with Back Deansgate;

(ii) The east side from its junction with Deans-gate to its junction with Howell's Yard:

Old Hall Street North:

The west side;

Oxford Street: Both sides;

Mealhouse Lane:

Both sides from its junction with Deansgate for a distance of 150 feet in a southerly direction;

and between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 6 p.m. from Monday to Friday (inclusive) or on Saturday between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 1 p.m. in the following length of road:

Old Hall Street North:

The east side.

The Order will be subject to certain exceptions relating to waiting necessary to enable:

- (a) boarding or alighting from a vehicle;
- (b) loading or unloading goods;
- (c) building operations, demolition, removal of obstructions to traffic, and maintenance of the length of road or the services therein.

Objections to the proposals must be sent in writing to the undersigned by the 1st June 1961.

The County Borough of Bolton (Various Street) (Prohibition of Waiting) (Nos. 2 to 7) Orders, 1961

The Bolton County Borough Council propose to make Orders under section 26 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles between 8.30 a.m. and 6 p.m. on any day other than Sunday in the following lengths of road:

No. 2 Order

St. George's Road:

(i) The north side:

- (a) From a point 154 feet west of its junction with Bath Street to a point 56 feet east of that junction;
- (b) From its junction with Higher Bridge Street for a distance of 139 feet in a westerly direction;

(ii) The south side:

- (a) From a point 45 feet west of its junction with Knowsley Street to a point 160 feet east of that junction;
- (b) From its junction with Bridge Street for a distance of 70 feet in a westerly direction.

Bath Street:

Both sides.

Higher Bridge Street :

(i) The west side from its junction with St. George's Road for a distance of 60 feet in a northerly direction;

(ii) The east side from its junction with St. George's Street for a distance of 135 feet in a nontherly direction.

St. George's Street :

The south side from its junction with Bridge Street for a distance of 121 feet in an easterly direction.

No. 3 Order

Knowsley Street:

(i) The west side:

(a) From its junction with Deansgate for distance of 189 feet in a northerly direction;

- (b) From its junction with St. George's Road for a distance of 107 feet in a southerly direction;
- (ii) The east side.

Corporation Street: The south side.
