Notice is hereby given that on the 24th day of March 1961 the Minister of Housing and Local Government amended the above Development Plan. The amendment relates to land situate within the Parish of Calverton in the Rural District of Basford.

Certified copies of the Development Plan as amended by the Minister have been deposited for public inspection at my office, at the office of the County Director of Planning, Shire Hall, Nottingham, and at the offices of the Basford Rural District Council, Rock House, Stockhill Lane, Basford, Nottingham, and they are available for inspection free of charge by all persons interested at the places mentioned between the hours of 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. from Monday to Friday inclusive.

The amendment became operative as from the 12th day of May 1961 but if any person aggrieved by it desires to question the validity thereof or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1947, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act or any Regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the making of the amendment he may within six weeks from the 12th day of May 1961 make application to the High Court.

## SURVEY OF PUBLIC RIGHTS OF WAY

*Definitive Map for South and East Berkshire*

The Berkshire County Council have, pursuant to Section 32 of the National Parks and Access to the Countryside Act, 1949, prepared a Definitive Map and Statement of public rights of way in those parts of the administrative County of Berkshire, comprising the Boroughs of Maidenhead, Newbury, Windsor and Wokingham and the Rural Districts of Bradfield, Cookham, Easthampstead, Hungerford, Newbury, Windsor and Wokingham.

A Definitive Map and Statement prepared under Section 32 of the Act is conclusive as to the particulars contained therein to the extent indicated in Section 32.

If any person desires to question the validity of the Definitive Map on the ground that the Map is not within the powers of the Act or on the ground that any requirement of the Act or of any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the preparation of the Map, or of any Draft or Provisional Map on which that Map is based, he may, within six weeks after the date of publication of this notice make an application to the High Court.

The whole of the said Definitive Map and Statement may be inspected during office hours (9.00 a.m. to 5.30 p.m. (7.30 p.m. Thursdays only)) at the County Record Office, Shire Hall, Reading, and at the following libraries during the hours stated:
